These Data Upload Terms apply when you upload, submit, link, provide, or make available any data, text, files, datasets, documents, prompts, code, tools, RAG systems, research materials, links, metadata, or other materials to Neurvance for AI training, fine-tuning, evaluation, research, documentation, community review, model development, dataset publication, open-source release, or public download.

These Data Upload Terms form part of the Neurvance Terms of Use and Privacy Policy.

By uploading or submitting data to Neurvance, you agree to these Data Upload Terms.

If you do not agree, you must not upload or submit data to Neurvance.

1. Purpose of Data Uploads

Neurvance allows users to submit data and related materials to support AI development.

Uploaded or submitted materials may be used for:

1. AI training;
2. AI fine-tuning;
3. AI evaluation;
4. AI safety testing;
5. AI research;
6. benchmark creation;
7. dataset creation;
8. documentation;
9. model cards;
10. source tracking;
11. quality review;
12. copyright and license review;
13. community review;
14. public model releases;
15. public dataset releases;

16. open-source releases;
17. public download by other users;
18. internal Neurvance development;
19. commercial Neurvance services.

User-submitted training data is separate from private AI chats. Private AI chats are not used for AI training or fine-tuning unless Neurvance changes its Privacy Policy and has a valid legal basis.

2. Upload Feature Requirements

To use the Neurvance upload feature, you must:

1. be at least 18 years old;
2. have a Neurvance account;
3. provide your real first and last name;
4. provide a valid email address;
5. accept these Data Upload Terms;
6. accept that accepted submissions may be publicly credited using your real first and last name;
7. confirm that the material does not contain personal data;
8. confirm that Neurvance and other users may download, use, copy, redistribute, study, and build on accepted public dataset releases, subject to the applicable release terms or license.

If you do not agree to real-name public credit, you cannot use the Neurvance data upload feature.

If your name is incorrect, fake, misleading, or submitted in bad faith, Neurvance may reject your submission, remove your upload access, suspend your account, or remove public credit.

3. What You May Submit

You may only submit data or materials if you have the legal right to submit them and if the material does not contain personal data.

You may submit materials that are:

1. in the public domain;
2. released under a license that allows AI training, fine-tuning, research, redistribution, documentation, public download, open-source release, and commercial use;
3. created by you and legally available for Neurvance and the public to use;
4. otherwise legally usable by Neurvance and other users for the purposes described in these Data Upload Terms.

You must provide accurate source information where relevant.

If you submit a link, dataset, file, book, article, website content, tool, codebase, prompt, RAG system, or other material, you must make sure that Neurvance is legally allowed to use, store, review, train on, fine-tune on, publish, redistribute, and make it available for public download.

4. Ban on Personal Data in Uploads

You must not upload or submit personal data through the Neurvance data upload feature.

For these Data Upload Terms, personal data means information that identifies, relates to, or could reasonably be connected to a living person.

You must not submit material containing:

1. names of living private individuals;
2. email addresses;
3. phone numbers;
4. home addresses;
5. usernames linked to real people;
6. ID numbers;

If your upload contains personal data, you must not submit it.

Neurvance may reject, delete, quarantine, or stop using any upload if Neurvance believes it contains personal data or creates a privacy risk.

Repeated or serious attempts to upload personal data may lead to suspension or ban.

5. What You Must Not Submit

You must not submit:

1. copyrighted material unless you have the rights or a suitable license;
2. pirated books, articles, datasets, code, media, or files;
3. private messages from other people;
4. confidential information;
5. trade secrets;
6. stolen data;
7. leaked data;
8. unlawfully scraped data;
9. personal data;
10. sensitive personal data;

11. information about minors;
12. medical records;
13. financial secrets;
14. passwords, tokens, private keys, API keys, or credentials;
15. malware, spyware, exploits, destructive code, or hidden harmful instructions;
16. data that violates privacy rights, copyright, database rights, contract terms, platform rules, or applicable law;
17. extremist, terrorist, illegal sexual, abusive, fraudulent, or harmful material;
18. material that you know or should know Neurvance cannot legally use;
19. material that Neurvance cannot legally redistribute or make publicly downloadable.

If you are unsure whether you have the right to submit something, do not submit it.

6. Your Legal Confirmation

By submitting data or materials to Neurvance, you confirm that:

1. you are at least 18 years old;
 2. the information you provide is accurate;
 3. you are using your real first and last name;
 4. you own the material or have all rights needed to submit it;
 5. the material is public domain, properly licensed, created by you, or otherwise legally usable by Neurvance;

 13. the material does not contain malware, hidden destructive instructions, or harmful code;
 14. you are not submitting the material in bad faith or to harm Neurvance, users, models, systems, or third parties.

7. License You Give to Neurvance

By submitting data or materials to Neurvance, you grant Neurvance a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, transferable, sublicensable license to use, store, copy, reproduce, process, clean, format, modify, adapt, analyse, evaluate, document, publish, display, distribute, redistribute, train on, fine-tune on, benchmark with, test with, create derivative works from, include in datasets, include in model documentation, include in open-source releases, include in public downloads, include in commercial systems, and otherwise use the submitted materials for Neurvance's AI models, tools, services, research, documentation, safety systems, evaluation systems, community systems, open-source releases, public dataset releases, and commercial operations.

This license is necessary because AI training, fine-tuning, evaluation, documentation, dataset creation, public dataset release, open-source release, and model development may require copying, processing, transforming, storing, analysing, publishing, distributing, and reusing submitted materials.

This license continues for as long as necessary for the purposes described in these Data Upload Terms, unless applicable law requires otherwise.

8. Public Dataset Release and Download

Accepted uploaded materials may be included in public datasets, dataset documentation, open-source repositories, release files, model cards, research notes, or other public Neurvance releases.

This means other users may be able to download accepted submitted materials.

If accepted materials are publicly released, other users may be able to:

1. view them;
2. download them;
3. copy them;
4. redistribute them;
5. study them;
6. use them for AI training or fine-tuning;
7. use them for research;
8. build tools, models, or datasets from them;
9. use them commercially if the applicable release license allows it.

Neurvance will aim to release datasets under clear release terms or an appropriate open-source/data license where practical.

Neurvance is not responsible for third-party copies, forks, downloads, mirrors, archives, or reuse after material has been publicly released.

9. Source Links and License Records

Neurvance may store the original source link, license information, proof of rights, submission records, timestamps, user confirmation records, and related metadata.

Neurvance may keep source links and license records long-term where necessary to:

1. verify rights;

4. maintain audit records;
5. prove what data was used;
6. investigate complaints;

11. Review and Rejection

12. Use in AI Models

If Neurvance accepts your submitted material, it may be used in AI training, fine-tuning, evaluation, safety testing, research, documentation, model development, dataset creation, public dataset release, open-source release, or public download.

You understand that AI training and fine-tuning may affect model weights, outputs, behaviour, evaluation records, research notes, and future model versions.

10. public dataset downloads;
11. forks;
12. mirrors;
13. archives;
14. downloads;
15. third-party copies;
16. systems already built using the material.

If Neurvance later discovers that submitted material contains personal data, Neurvance may remove, restrict, anonymise, or stop using the material where required or appropriate.

13. Backups

Neurvance may keep model backups, dataset backups, pre-model backups, checkpoints, source records, license records, and training records for at least 30 days.

Neurvance may keep certain backups and records longer where necessary for:

1. copyright review;
2. license review;
3. safety review;
4. auditability;
5. legal compliance;
6. dispute handling;
7. model rollback;
8. security;
9. research integrity;
10. proving what data was used or not used;
11. investigating whether personal data was wrongly submitted.

Backups may not be deleted immediately when active data is deleted.

Where personal data is accidentally submitted, Neurvance will handle backup deletion and restriction according to applicable data protection law and technical feasibility.

14. Removal Requests

You may contact Neurvance to request removal of:

1. your public credit;
2. your name from public attribution;
3. personal data connected to your submission, if any was accidentally submitted;
4. certain submitted materials where legally and technically practical.

Neurvance may delay, remove, reject, or stop using submissions where necessary for legal, safety, privacy, security, copyright, technical, financial, or operational reasons.

20. Relationship to Other Neurvance Terms
