

Terms of Use for neurvance.com

Last updated: 06-07-2026

These Terms of Use ("Terms") govern access to and use of neurvance.com, related services, AI systems, community voting features, downloadable models, tools, research materials, documentation, and any other services made available by Neurvance ("Neurvance", "we", "us", or "our").

Neurvance is operated by Adam Samer Daabas, a Danish sole proprietorship.

Business information

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By creating an account, accessing neurvance.com, using the Neurvance services, participating in votes, submitting content, using Neurvance AI models, downloading models or tools, or otherwise interacting with Neurvance, you agree to these Terms.

If you do not agree to these Terms, you must not use Neurvance.

1. Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old to use Neurvance.

By using Neurvance, you confirm that:

1. you are at least 18 years old;
2. you have the legal capacity to enter into these Terms;
3. all information you provide to Neurvance is accurate and not misleading;
4. you will comply with these Terms and all applicable laws.

Neurvance may refuse, suspend, or terminate access if we reasonably believe that a user is under 18, has provided false information, or has breached these Terms.

2. What Neurvance Is

Neurvance is a community-focused AI project and platform. Its goal is to place AI development more directly in the hands of users by allowing eligible users to participate in votes, propose improvements, submit data, submit tools, contribute to fine-tuning decisions, and help decide how Neurvance AI systems should develop.

Neurvance focuses on smaller, purpose-specific AI models. These models are not intended to be on the same scale as large general-purpose AI systems such as GPT, Claude, Gemini, or similar large language models. Neurvance models may be general in use, but they are smaller and are intended to be improved through specific fine-tuning, tools, RAG systems, community voting, research, and open development.

Neurvance may allow users to:

1. create accounts;
2. chat with AI models through Neurvance servers;
3. vote on proposals;
4. submit proposals;
5. submit datasets, prompts, tools, RAG systems, or related materials;
6. download open-source models and tools;
7. host certain models locally;
8. participate in community voting.

3. Accounts

You must create and maintain an account to use core Neurvance features, including AI chat on the website, voting, submitting proposals, and submitting content.

You are responsible for keeping your login details secure. You must not share your account with another person or allow another person to vote, submit content, access paid features, or use Neurvance through your account.

You are responsible for all activity that occurs through your account unless the activity was caused by Neurvance's own security failure.

You must notify Neurvance as soon as possible if you believe your account has been accessed without permission.

Neurvance may suspend or terminate accounts that are used for abuse, manipulation, illegal activity, vote buying, bot activity, spam, security attacks, or other harmful conduct.

4. AI Chat on Neurvance Servers

Users may access certain AI models through neurvance.com. Use of AI models on Neurvance servers may require payment, subscription, credits, donation-supported access, or another access model determined by Neurvance.

Neurvance may change pricing, access limits, model availability, server availability, and usage rules at any time, subject to applicable law and any specific paid plan terms.

Neurvance may limit or suspend AI chat access if needed for safety, abuse prevention, technical stability, legal compliance, cost control, or protection of Neurvance.

When users interact with AI systems on neurvance.com, Neurvance will aim to make clear that users are interacting with AI where required by applicable law.

5. Downloading and Local Hosting

Neurvance may make certain AI models, tools, code, datasets, documentation, or research materials available for download.

Where Neurvance releases materials under an open-source license, the applicable license will control your rights to copy, modify, distribute, or use those materials.

Unless otherwise stated, Neurvance open-source releases are intended to be released under the Apache License 2.0.

You are responsible for your own use of downloaded models, tools, code, datasets, or materials. If you host, modify, deploy, fine-tune, connect, redistribute, or use Neurvance materials locally or on your own systems, you are solely responsible for that use.

Neurvance is not responsible for harm, loss, misuse, unlawful use, security issues, outputs, or damage caused by your local hosting, modification, redistribution, deployment, or use of Neurvance materials.

You must keep attribution to Neurvance where required by the applicable open-source license, documentation, model card, NOTICE file, or release terms.

6. Commercial Use and Licensing

Personal and commercial use of publicly released Neurvance open-source models and tools may be allowed, subject to the applicable open-source license and these Terms.

Nervance AI systems are not a substitute for professional advice. You must not rely on Nervance AI systems for medical, legal, financial, psychological, emergency, safety-critical, or other high-risk decisions without review by a qualified professional.

You are responsible for evaluating AI outputs before using, publishing, acting on, or relying on them.

Nervance does not guarantee that AI outputs will be accurate, lawful, non-infringing, safe, confidential, or appropriate.

8. Prohibited Uses

You must not use Nervance, Nervance models, Nervance tools, Nervance servers, downloaded materials, voting systems, or community features to:

1. break the law;
2. violate the rights of another person;
3. create, assist, or distribute malware, spyware, phishing, credential theft, or hacking tools;
4. commit fraud, scams, impersonation, deception, or social engineering;
5. harass, threaten, abuse, exploit, or dox any person;
6. generate or distribute illegal sexual content;
7. exploit minors or attempt to interact sexually with minors;
8. create or promote extremist violence, terrorism, or illegal violent activity;
9. produce instructions for weapons, evasion of law enforcement, or serious physical harm;
10. submit copyrighted, private, stolen, confidential, or unlawfully obtained data;
11. manipulate votes, buy votes, sell votes, use bots, or create fake accounts;
12. interfere with Nervance servers, security systems, models, voting systems, datasets, or infrastructure;
13. attempt to bypass rate limits, payment systems, safety systems, access controls, or moderation;
14. use Nervance in a way that creates legal, safety, privacy, security, reputational, or operational risk for Nervance.

Neurvance may suspend, restrict, or terminate access immediately if we reasonably believe these rules have been violated.

9. Community Voting

Eligible logged-in users may participate in Neurvance community voting.

Unless Neurvance states otherwise, each eligible user has one vote.

All eligible users vote on the same basis. These Terms do not create any special user office, user management role, representative role, employment role, partnership role, ownership role, or special class of voters.

Users may vote on proposals relating to Neurvance models, tools, RAG systems, fine-tuning direction, open-source releases, community submissions, feature ideas, research direction, and other matters made available for voting by Neurvance.

A vote must normally remain open for at least one week.

At least 20 eligible users must vote for a vote to be automatically valid. If fewer than 20 eligible users vote, the vote does not automatically pass, and Neurvance may approve, reject, repeat, delay, or modify the result.

Public votes are binding only where Neurvance clearly states that the specific vote is binding. Otherwise, public votes are advisory.

No vote may approve anything illegal, unsafe, privacy-invasive, discriminatory, abusive, fraudulent, harmful, copyright-infringing, security-risky, financially irresponsible, or contrary to Neurvance's legal obligations.

Neurvance may pause, cancel, reject, modify, or review any vote where necessary for legal compliance, safety, privacy, security, financial stability, contractual obligations, AI safety, or protection of Neurvance.

Community voting does not give users ownership, control, employment rights, salary rights, profit rights, management rights, partnership rights, representative rights, or any automatic right to payment.

10. Proposals and Community Decisions

Eligible users may submit proposals where Neurvance makes proposal features available.

Neurvance may review proposals before they are published, voted on, implemented, or released.

Neurvance may reject, delay, edit, group, clarify, remove, or refuse proposals where necessary for legal compliance, safety, privacy, security, copyright, quality, technical feasibility, cost control, financial stability, abuse prevention, or protection of Neurvance.

Neurvance aims to be open and transparent about its AI models, tools, research, data use, benchmarks, and development process.

New fine-tuned models should normally be uploaded publicly within 2 weeks after completion.

New models should normally be uploaded publicly within 1.5 months after completion.

Tools such as RAG systems, automation systems, evaluation systems, or other AI-related tools should normally be released within 2 weeks after development.

However, Neurvance may delay, restrict, modify, or refuse release of any model, dataset, tool, research material, system, or documentation if release may create legal risk, privacy risk, copyright risk, safety risk, security risk, misuse risk, contractual risk, reputational risk, financial risk, or serious technical risk.

Where possible, Neurvance may publish safe information such as benchmarks, safety evaluations, model cards, research notes, or general explanations, even if the full model, tool, dataset, or system is delayed or not released.

Neurvance is not required to release anything where doing so would create legal, safety, privacy, security, contractual, financial, operational, or technical problems.

12. User Submissions

Users may submit data, text, files, datasets, prompts, tools, RAG systems, code, evaluations, research, comments, proposals, votes, and other materials to Neurvance ("User Submissions").

Before submitting data or content for training, fine-tuning, research, evaluation, redistribution, or documentation, users may be required to check a confirmation box or otherwise confirm that they accept the applicable submission terms.

By submitting User Submissions, you confirm that:

1. you are at least 18 years old;
2. you own the submission or have all required rights and permissions;
3. the submission is public domain, properly licensed, or otherwise legally usable for AI training, fine-tuning, research, evaluation, redistribution, documentation, and commercial use;
4. you have provided accurate source information where relevant;

5. the submission does not violate copyright, privacy, confidentiality, database rights, trade secrets, contract terms, platform rules, or applicable law;
6. the submission does not contain personal data unless you have a lawful basis and all required permissions;
7. the submission does not contain malware, harmful code, hidden instructions, security exploits, or destructive functionality;
8. the submission is not misleading, fraudulent, stolen, or unlawfully obtained.

Neurvance may reject, remove, stop using, review, quarantine, or delete User Submissions if rights cannot be verified, if the submission may be unsafe, or if the submission may create legal, privacy, security, copyright, technical, financial, or reputational risk.

13. License to User Submissions

By submitting User Submissions to Neurvance, you grant Neurvance a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, transferable, sublicensable license to use, host, store, copy, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, display, distribute, analyse, evaluate, document, train on, fine-tune on, create derivative works from, commercialise, and otherwise use the submission for Neurvance's services, AI models, tools, research, documentation, safety systems, evaluation systems, open-source releases, and commercial operations.

This license is necessary for Neurvance to use submitted materials in AI development, fine-tuning, research, community review, documentation, and model release workflows.

10. systems already created using the submission.

Neurvance may keep backups of pre-models, datasets, logs, records, and earlier versions where needed for copyright review, safety review, auditability, legal compliance, security, dispute handling, or operational continuity.

15. Community Tools, RAG Systems, and User-Built Systems

Neurvance may review submitted tools before implementation.

Neurvance may reject, modify, delay, disable, or remove community-submitted tools at any time for safety, security, legal compliance, technical quality, copyright, privacy, misuse prevention, or operational reasons.

If a submitted tool causes harm because of an honest mistake, Neurvance may review the situation and decide what action is appropriate.

If a user knowingly submits malicious, destructive, illegal, hacked, unsafe, or harmful tools or materials, Neurvance may suspend or ban the user and may take legal action.

Users are responsible for the tools, code, datasets, prompts, and systems they submit.

16. Credit and Public Attribution

Neurvance may publicly credit users for accepted submissions, proposals, tools, datasets, research contributions, or other contributions.

By submitting materials, you agree that Neurvance may display your name, username, contribution history, and related attribution in connection with your submission.

You may request removal of your public credit or name from public display. Neurvance will review such requests and remove public credit where legally and technically practical.

20. Donations by Neurvance

Neurvance may keep backups, records, logs, or evidence where needed for legal, safety, security, dispute, or compliance reasons.

Neurvance may update, modify, suspend, restrict, or discontinue any part of the service, including models, tools, voting systems, subscriptions, downloads, community features, and community voting processes.

Neurvance may update these Terms when necessary for legal compliance, safety, privacy, security, financial stability, new features, business changes, operational needs, or the long-term future of Neurvance.

If changes are material, Neurvance will aim to provide reasonable notice where practical.

Continued use of Neurvance after updated Terms become effective means you accept the updated Terms.

If you do not accept updated Terms, you must stop using Neurvance.

Before bringing a legal claim, you agree to contact Neurvance at legal@neurvance.com and attempt to resolve the issue informally, unless applicable law gives you the right to act immediately.

Where legally permitted, disputes shall be handled by the competent courts of Denmark.

30. Final Authority

Nothing in these Terms, any vote, any proposal, any model release, any tool release, any transparency report, any donation goal, or any community decision allows Neurvance, Adam Samer Daabas, users, voters, partners, or contributors to approve anything illegal.
